Petitioner-Amit @ Monu has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.328 dated 18.04.2016, registered at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar, under Sections 302, 307 and 34 IPC, Sections 216 and 120-B IPC, added later on and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, Kamal and Sumit @ Kali committed the murder of Sweeti and the

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present petitioner is the main conspirator. The prosecution evidence is still going on.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and nature and gravity of the offence, I find that at this stage, there is every chance of tampering with the evidence by the petitioner, if he is released on bail. Therefore, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
