FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that he along with his co-accused Joginder Singh @ Bhan Singh for sorting out a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner side and complainant side consisting of Paramjit Kaur and Baldev Singh regarding which dispute earlier an FIR has been registered a fight has ensued and it is alleged that the accused side trespassed into the house of the complainant and caused injuries. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that no injury is attributed to the petitioner and only *lalkara* is alleged to have been raised by him and similarly placed co-accused Joginder Singh has been allowed bail vide order dated 24.3.2017 of this Court.

Though, the factual scenario has not been disputed by

the learned State counsel but he has stoutly opposed the grant of the bail to the petitioner.

Considering the submissions of the two sides it is not by any means put to question by the learned State counsel that it is a case of version and counter version and that even the petitioner side too have received injuries and, thus, a debatable issue has arisen as to which of the party was aggressor.

In view thereof and keeping in view the principle of parity and that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
