SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is the accused person in F.I.R No.11, dated 17.02.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1), have prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings pending in the Court of Ld. Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khamano, on the basis of compromise.

[2]. During pendency of petition, the complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused vide Compromise Deed (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by him. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Ld. Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khamano, vide report dated 03.06.2016,

filed in CRM-M-10047-2016 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[3]. Respondent Nos.2 and 3 are represented by their counsel.

[4]. In view of the report of Ld. Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khamano, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”**, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and **“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”**, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/accused person.

[5]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.11, dated 17.02.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 148 & 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
