Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.843 dated 30.06.2015 under Sections 420, 177 I.P.C. and Section 31 of the Representation of People Act, pertaining to Police Station Gurgaon City, District Gurgaon (now named as Gurugram), on the basis of compromise dated 11.08.2016 (Annexure P-2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 23.05.2017, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court on 02.06.2017 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram on 02.06.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise. Report bearing No.277 dated 05.06.2017 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurugram vide letter bearing No.2670/C.29 dated 06.06.2017 has also been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram, the compromise between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or greed.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.843 qua the petitioner, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
