This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 211 dated 28.09.2013, registered under Sections 304-B and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 28.09.2013. He is the husband of the deceased. It is submitted that the complainant has been examined. It is also contended that the petitioner and his all family member, including his married sisters, have falsely been implicated in this case. However, on investigation, the allegations against the married sisters were found to be false, therefore, they were declared innocent. It is also submitted that the mother of the petitioner has already been admitted to the concession of regular bail.

Upon notice, Mr. A. A. Pathak, Addl. A. G., Punjab, has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner by contending that there is specific allegations against

the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody 28.09.2013 and the mother-in-law has already been granted bail, without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
