Counsel for respondent No. 2 has apprised the court that the alleged victim of the crime came from Germany and has been examined before the trial court.

Counsel for the State has submitted that out of 13 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 9 have already been examined and evidence of the prosecution is likely to be concluded shortly.

Keeping in view the stage of trial which has reached almost at the final stage, I do not think it to be a fit case wherein exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code,

extraordinary in nature, is warranted. That being so, the present petition is disposed of but without prejudice to rights of the petitioner to raise all available pleas before the trial court.
