Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.103 dated 24.12.2016, registered under Sections 454, 380, 511 IPC, at Police Station Ghanour, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 23.01.2017, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sher Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and at this stage is no longer needed by the investigating agency.

In the view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 23.01.2017 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing observed herein above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
