Present petition is for grant of bail to the petitioner in complaint case Crime No.26 dated 28.05.2013, under Sections 8, 18, 29 and 60 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station N.C.B., Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition but the petitioner is in custody since 22.07.2016 and as the trial is lingering on, some directions be issued to learned trial Judge to conclude the trial within a specific time.

Learned State counsel contended that only three witnesses are yet to be examined and the trial can be concluded within three months.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to learned trial Judge to conclude the trial expeditiously and practically within three months.
