Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently contended that the investigation has not been conducted fairly because the respondent is closely related to the high ranking police officer in the same District. He therefore prayed for handing over of the investigation to some other agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Suresh Kumar, PS Morinda, makes categorical statement that after investigation the challan has been filed on 06.03.2017 before the appropriate Court.

In that view of the matter, this is not possible to issue any directions as prayed for. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy as available under law after filing of the challan.
