This petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. with prayer for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 23.08.2016 in CRM-M-28584 of 2016 titled as Pargat Singh Vs. State of Punjab, in case FIR No.113 dated 27.06.2016, registered at P.S.Sadar Khanna, District Ludhiana under Sections 376/511/457 IPC.

Learned counsel for the State submits on instructions from HC Mahender Singh and as per Annexure P-5 that during enquiry on the complaint made by the petitioner, Pargat Singh-respondent No.2 tried to grapple with the complainant. Even he did not understand by understanding by the police officials. On apprehending threat to law and order, Pargat Singh was arrested by the police and proceeding under Section 107/151 Cr.P.C. were initiated. After taking huge surety under Section 116(2) for the good character of accused Pargat Singh, he was herby bound for one

Keeping in view the fact that respondent No.2 even in the police station had grappled with the petitioner/complainant and misbehaved with her, the regular bail granted to him vide order dated 23.08.2016 in CRM-M-28584 of 2016 is hereby cancelled. The petition stands allowed accordingly.
