Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.35 dated 15.04.2017, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Sadar Kot Fatta, District Bathinda. This Court had made an order dated 24.05.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from police official, makes a statement that after obtaining interim bail order from this Court, the petitioner was found in possession of 65 grams of Heroin.

However, since in the present case, there is an interim order made by this Court on 24.05.2017, the same is made absolute. Petitioner shall furnish an undertaking before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future.

Petitioner shall attend the police station concerned on every alternative

day between 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM, provided he is not in custody.

Petition stands disposed of.
