The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, after FIR bearing no.46, dated 28.04.2016 was registered against them, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 323, 341, read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

The petitioners had been admitted to interim bail at the time when notice was issued on 01.06.2016. Thereafter, as recorded in the order dated 29.09.2016, learned counsel for the petitioners had stated that the petitioners are in the process of paying ₹1,50,000/- to the complainant. Though it is not recorded in that order, however it has been admitted by learned counsel for the petitioners, as also by learned counsel for the complainant, that the payment was in respect of the final settlement to be

reached.

On 02.03.2017 it had been recorded that the entire amount would be paid to the complainant by today and consequently the matter was adjourned till today.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioners has handed over to learned counsel for the complainant a demand draft for a sum of ₹1,15,000/-, which learned counsel for the complainant submits actually discharges the settlement reached between the parties.

Though of course a criminal case has been registered against the petitioners for the alleged commission of the aforesaid offences, however, in view of the fact that the offences are not such as would debar an amicable settlement, I do not see any impediment in making the order dated 01.06.2016 absolute.

Ordered accordingly.
