The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.20 dated 10.02.2016 registered under 302 and 34 IPC at Police Station Ladhawal, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner (brother-in-law of the deceased) and Baljeet Singh her husband are said to have been regularly assaulting her. She lodged the report on 25.01.2016. Thereafter, she died on 10.02.2016. Her mother then lodged the FIR in question.

Kulwinder Kaur had died. Unfortunately she was repeatedly assaulted by family members of the husband and husband as well. Be that as it may. Looking to the fact that she had died and the nature of the weapon used to assault her and the relationship of the petitioner as a brother-in-law (brother of husband), I am inclined to grant bail to the

petitioner as there is no reason to put him in custody as under trial particularly when prima facie the lower offences were made out.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-18788 OF 2017 is allowed
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
