Petitioner-Municipal Corporation Faridabad filed the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India challenging the Labour Court award dated 17.8.2000 passed by Presiding Officer, Labour Court-II, Faridabad whereby respondent-workman Mukesh Kumar was ordered to be reinstated with continuity of service along with 80% back wages.

The writ petition was referred to the Lok Adalat.

During the pendency of the writ petition it was apprised that the respondent-workman by virtue of the said award had already been reinstated and also regularised. The dispute was left only with regard to the payment of 80% back wages. The respondent-workman had agreed to take 40% back wages instead of 80% back wages, so awarded by the Labour Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner today has apprised that the appropriate authority has accorded approval for the grant of 40% back wages. He states that the said amount would be paid within 45 days.

In view of the said situation, the present writ petition stands disposed of in the manner indicated above. However, it is made clear that if the amount is not paid within 45 days, the amount will carry 12% interest p.a. on the said delayed payment from the date of this order.
