By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.94, dated 04.02.2016, registered under Sections 332, 353, 506 and 186 read with Section 34 IPC, at P.S. City Gurugram, Distt. Gurugram.

On 02.06.2017, the following order was passed:-

“After seeing the video clip which has been produced in Court today, I consider it appropriate to admit the petitioner to interim anticipatory bail till the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 18.07.2017.

In the meanwhile, in case of the arrest of the petitioner, he would be immediately released on bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Ilqa Magistrate.”

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in

pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 02.06.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
