Petitioner has prayed for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for protecting his life and personal liberty from being infringed by respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondents No.4 to 7 are residents of “Jassi Dancer Da Makaan” in which the petitioner at one point of time was doing the job of playing electronic harmonium. Respondent No.4 was a dancer in the group.

Petitioner has levelled allegations against the private respondents and has alleged complicity of private respondents in number of cases and the threats given to the petitioner.

Petitioner has already moved a representation before respondent No.3 for protection of his civil rights by alleging that

the private respondents are dreaded criminals and are running interstate gang of fraud and extortionists.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Ghuman, Additional A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the pending representation of the petitioner in accordance with law.
