The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.75 dated 17.04.2017 registered under Sections 406, 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and seen the FIR.

Looking to the allegations against the petitioner that the small amounts for processing fee and legal fee were collected, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in the aforesaid FIR on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
