Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.69 dated 01.02.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 341, 302, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad.

The role attributed to the petitioner is of conspiracy viz-a-viz Joginder @ Golu who in turn conspired with others after having received money from the petitioner and after purchasing pistol from one Ansar who was allegedly introduced by the petitioner. Petitioner has been nominated as an accused on the basis of disclosure statement of Joginder @ Golu, the main

accused. As per disclosure statement of Joginder @ Golu, petitioner provided money and introduced Joginder @ Golu with Ansar who in turn provided new pistols and cartridges to Joginder @ Golu.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Vinod Kumar submits that challan has been presented. As per the challan, there is no mention about the amount contributed by the petitioner for the purchase of weapon in question. Ansar has been found to be innocent during course of investigation. The complicity of the petitioner would remain debatable.

In view of above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
