Pursuant to the order dated 01.06.2017, the petitioner, Sh.Gurnam Singh, is stated to have met the IGP, NRI Cell, Punjab, Mohali, and pursuant to his having met him in the morning, Mr. Rajvinder Singh Sohal, AIG, NRI Cell, Mohali, is present in Court and has stated that protection has been provided to the petitioner to enable him to go to his village, Bhatija, falling under the jurisdiction of Police Station, Maqsudan, District Jalandhar. The petitioner being present in person, states that he has been provided protection, but he further states that he is not able to construct a shed on his land. The AIG, on query, submits that the petitioner is one of the co-sharers of the land and has been allowed to stay there by his co-sharers.

Without making any comment on the contention of the petitioner with regard to any ownership of the land, or with regard to the contention of the AIG with regard to any other co-sharers of the land, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, protection of

life and liberty having been given to the petitioner.

As regards his rights qua the land, he would avail of his civil remedies as per law.

Efforts of the NRI Cell, Punjab, to solve the problem within one day, needs to be highly appreciated.
