This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 127 dated 11.04.2016, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Gohana, District Sonipat.

The petitioner is in custody since 21.06.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per statement (Annexure P-3) got recorded by the prosecutrix under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she had gone with one Pawan to Gharwal and thereafter, to Jhanj. In this statement, no allegation has been levelled against the present petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Samunder Singh, has informed that after presentation of challan, charges have already been framed 09 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonipat.
