Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.156 dated 12.11.2016, under Section 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner is in jail for the last 9 months and 3 days as on 16.8.2017. Learned Counsel for the parties are ad idem that he is already on bail in the other case registered against him. Trial will take its own time. Hence, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to the petitioner furnishing an undertaking in writing that he will not indulge in similar offence or any other offence. The police shall have a surveillance over the activities of the petitioner. The petitioner shall report to the concerned Police Station on every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday between 10 AM to 4 PM.
