Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the grant of regular bail in FIR No.14, dated 30.01.2015, registered under Sections 307, 34, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

Seeking regular bail for the petitioner, learned counsel submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 05.04.2016; all other co-accused including the main accused-Avtar Khan @ Pammi have been granted regular bail by this Court and that since only 02 out of the total 19 witnesses cited by the prosecution have been examined, the trial is not likely to conclude in the near future.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the above factual position.

Since the petitioner has been in custody for over 01 year and 01 month; the trial is not likely to conclude in the near future and all the

co-accused including the main accused-Avtar Khan @ Pammi, who had approached this Court through **CRM-M No.28564 of 2016**, through order dated 29.08.2016 has been granted regular bail, the petitioner is also held entitled to be admitted to regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.

If the petitioner is found indulging in any other criminal activity/misusing the concession of bail granted to him, it would be open to the State to move an appropriate application before the Competent Court/this Court for cancellation of the bail granted to the petitioner through this order.
