Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the case FIR No. 10 of 12.3.2015 under Sections 498-A, 494, 406, 420 and 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for petitioner informs that over ₹ 45.00 lacs were offered to the complainant for full and final settlement of the case. This, however, is not acceptable to the complainant as one time settlement.

Keeping in view the fact that mediation has already failed, interim bail granted by this Court on 4.6.2015 is made absolute, subject to condition that petitioner will make FD of ₹ 10.00 lacs in the name of the

complainant and deposit the same before the trial Court. Fate of the said FD will be decided by the trial Court at the final stage of the trial.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
