By virtue of second petition preferred under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought the regular bail during the pendency of the trial in case bearing FIR No.149, dated April 29, 2016, under Sections 307, 452, 34 IPC (Section 302 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station A-Division, District Amritsar City.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he does not want to proceed with instant petition and withdraws the same, in case, a direction is issued to the trial court to dispose of the trial within some specified period as the petitioner is behind the bars for the last more than one year.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits or commenting upon the merits of the case, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn but with the direction to trial court to dispose of the trial on priority basis but not later than three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
