Petitioner-Dharampal has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.124 dated 24.04.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind, under Sections 170, 406, 420 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested this petition.

Complainant has also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that there are serious allegations against the present petitioner. As per the complaint, the present petitioner was impersonating himself as Chairman, HSSC Board and was using blue beacon overhead the car without any authority. He alongwith co-accused extorted money from the complainant for getting appointment.

Learned counsel for complainant stated that compromise has taken place between the parties. Complainant-Basantrai present in Court today informed this Court that yesterday, money was returned to him by the petitioner.

However, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and earlier also, the petitioner has been convicted in such type of offences, as argued by learned State counsel, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
