This order shall dispose of two petitions bearing Nos. CRM-M-19109 of 2017 for quashing of FIR No. 18 dated 21.03.2013 (Annexure P1) under Sections 452/323/324/148 and 149 IPC (Sections 325 & 201 IPC added and Section 452 IPC deleted subsequently at the time of presentation of challan) registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P2) arrived at between the parties; and

CRM-M-19106 of 2017 for quashing of cross-case i.e. report No.15 dated 22.03.2013 recorded in abovesaid FIR, under Sections 341/323/324/506 and 201 IPC (Added later on at the time of challan) registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpura, District Rupnagar and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P3) arrived between the parties.

Vide order dated 25.05.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court, for getting their statements recorded. In compliance thereof, statements of parties were record and learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rupnagar, has submitted its report dated 05.06.2017 which *inter alia* stipulates that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, with their free will and consent.

In view of the above, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and that is not only for the betterment of warring groups, but a semblance for the growth of society. Consequently, this Court is satisfied that it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR as well as cross-case i.e. report No. 15 dated 22.03.2013 recorded in the abovementioned FIR and proceedings resulting therefrom.

Consequently, the petitions are allowed. FIR No. 18 dated 21.03.2013 (Annexure P1) under Sections 452/323/324/148 and 149 IPC (Sections 325 & 201 IPC added and Section 452 IPC deleted subsequently at the time of presentation of challan) registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar as well as cross-case i.e. report No.15 dated 22.03.2013 recorded in abovesaid FIR, under Sections 341/323/324/506 and 201 IPC (Added later on at the time of challan)
