On the basis of secret information, police party conducted a raid. Two persons were spotted while taking livestock driving them from behind towards village Chuharpur. On sighting the Government vehicle, both of them ran towards village Chauharpur and could not be apprehended. Petitioner was identified by the informer who was running away with the plastic bag. The second person could not be identified. In order to ascertain the complicity of second person, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary. Four weak and feeble cows and bullocks were recovered, which were being taken away for the purposes of slaughtering. In order to ascertain the *modus operandi* of the accused, concession of anticipatory bail cannot be granted.

Dismissed.
