This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 716 dated 27.10.2016, under Sections 498-A, 304-B read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

The petitioner is in custody since 14.11.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is father-in-law of the deceased. Vide order dated 04.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court, anticipatory bail was granted to son of petitioner namely Sandeep (husband of deceased) by observing that he was not present at the spot when his wife had committed suicide and after completion of investigation, he was not required for custodial interrogation. Learned counsel further contends that allegations against the present petitioner are general in nature. Minor child of the deceased is staying with the family of

the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, has informed that after presentation of the challan, charges are yet to be framed and the trial is fixed for 05.06.2017.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhiwani.
