In response to the order dated 08.03.2017, an affidavit of Dr. Inderjeet Singh Dhankhar, Civil Surgeon, Government Hospital, Panipat, has been filed in Court today, by the learned State counsel, in which, to summarise, it is stated that the X-ray of the right hip joint of the petitioner, (Reshma Devi) would appear to be a fresh fracture and not an old one.

In view of the aforesaid opinion of the Board constituted to examine the petitioner, Mr. Tiwari further submits that an FIR has been registered against 11 persons (including one unknown person) and two persons have been arrested, the FIR being registered for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Section 148, 149, 323, 325 and 506 IPC. The aforesaid information is also given in the affidavit of the

Superintendent of Police, Panipat, filed in Court today, with the Superintendent also present in Court, pursuant to the aforesaid order of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on the other hand submits that the FIR in question even now has not been registered for offences punishable in terms of the IPC for entry into a household etc.

The Superintendent of Police has assured the Court that he would further go into the matter and if it is found that the commission of other offences is also made out, needful action would be taken.

It has also been stated that an enquiry has been initiated against police officials prima facie found responsible for dereliction of duty.

On the aforesaid statement and keeping in view the action already taken, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such, with all the parties left to avail of their remedies as per law, at various stages.
