RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

As per allegations in the FIR, Taran Randhawa tried to hit the brother of the complainant with *kirpan* blow on his head which was timely warded off by the brother of the complainant and the blow ultimately landed on the little finger of his right hand.

Though the Court of Sessions has described the injury to be grievous in nature, however, learned State counsel on instructions from HC Rajinder Singh submitted that the injury in

question was found to be simple in nature. The injury with *kirpan* on the person of the complainant was also found to be simple in nature.

In view of above, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 08.06.2017 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
