The petitioner, who is a woman of 70 years of age, has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.443 dated 30.04.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Gurugram.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Undoubtedly, the allegations are against the company which caused loss to the investors and the petitioner is the director thereof. From the perusal of the entire petition and the medical record filed therewith I find that there is hardly any point in getting her arrested. The medical record shows that she is facing neurological problems. I am satisfied that the medical record thus show serious neurological ailments.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-19196 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) Interim order dated 25.05.2017 is made absolute.
