Petitioner who has faced incarceration since 12.09.2016, seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.141 dated 12.09.2016, under Sections 379-B, 452, 323, 324 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Beas, Tehsil and District Amritsar.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Mandeep Kaur. Allegations against the petitioner are of having snatched the ear rings. As per prosecution version, even injuries were caused upon the person of the complainant even though the same have been opined to be simple in nature.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan has been presented and the charges have been framed.

Out of 10 prosecution witnesses cited, seven have already been examined.

Against the backdrop of the allegations and coupled with the length of incarceration already suffered, the petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Petition disposed of.
