HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.320 dated 10.08.2016 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302, 120-B IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani (Haryana).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody for the last about 11 months. The petitioner has not been named in the FIR and there is no other case against him. He has referred to order dated 30.05.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M-14985-2017 titled as 'Anaro Versus State of Haryana' to contend that the co-accused, namely, Anaro has been admitted on regular bail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Kaptan Singh, has stated that the petitioner is involved in the case and on his disclosure statement, a mobile phone and motorcycle, used in the crime, were taken in possession.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The very fact that a mobile phone and motorcycle, used in the crime, were recovered on the basis of disclosure statement of the petitioner. The plea of the petitioner that he is not named in the FIR cannot be accepted. Moreover, learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner was actively in touch with the other co-accused on his mobile phone. Hence, the plea of the petitioner that he was not connected with the crime cannot be accepted. So far as the reliance placed on the order in Anaro (supra) is concerned, she was admitted on regular bail being a lady and on the ground that no specific injury was attributed to her.

In view of above, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed.
