Learned counsel for the complainant has appeared and has vehemently contended that the petitioner is equally involved in duping the complainant into giving ₹ 28 lacs, as it was given to the petitioner alongwith her husband.

He further submits that details of the complainant withdrawing money from his account, to pay to the petitioner and her husband, have been given to the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, submits that the petitioner is also found to be involved in a similar case along with her husband, in respect of which an FIR has been also lodged.

In view of the aforesaid facts, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is dismissed and the interim order is vacated.
