Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.113 dated 30.07.2016, under Section 18 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Rahon, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in jail since 30.07.2016.

Allegation against the petitioner is that 4 Kg. opium was recovered from him during *naka* at disclosed place held by the police.

Upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, learned counsel for the State submits that there is no other case is pending against the petitioner. He further submits that the trial has been completed.

In that view of the matter, I think that there is no point in keeping the petitioner in the jail. Hence, the petitioner be released on

bail, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The **CRM-M-19332 of 2017** is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
- (iv) The petitioner shall report to the concerned Police Station on every Sunday, Monday and Wednesday between 11 am to 4 pm. The police shall keep surveillance on the petitioner.
- (v) The petitioner would file an undertaking to the trial Court.
- (vi) Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
- (vii) In case, the petitioner violates the above said conditions, this order of bail comes to an end automatically without reference to this Court.
