ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.28 dated 05.04.2010 under Sections 448/511/427/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise dated 20.04.2010 arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that parties are related to each other and the FIR was registered due to some misunderstanding which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 18.01.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class,

Phillaur, District Jalandhar, has sent his report dated 07.02.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The parties are related to each other and the FIR is outcome of a misunderstanding which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.28 dated 05.04.2010 under Sections 448/511/427/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
