INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Wasim has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.114 dated 13.05.2016, registered at Police Station Ellenabad, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 477 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that Jaswant Singh is the main accused, who opened a bank account and deposited cheque etc.

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However, the cheque has not been got encashed, but as per the allegation, main accused-Jaswant singh has withdrawn Rs.90,000/- from ATM. The allegation against the present petitioner is with regard to conspiracy.

The petitioner has been in custody since 13.12.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Moreover, co-accused, Mohammad Imran, in the similar circumstances, has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 23.05.2017 passed in CRM-M-15262-2017.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
