The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 30 dated 15.04.2017, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala (now SAS Nagar Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and no recovery has been effected from him.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 01.06.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Mohan Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 01.06.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not

required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 01.06.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
