The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 to 7 and also to take action against official respondent No.4 who is hand in gloves with the private respondents No.5 to 7 and are not taking action upon the applications moved by the petitioner.

On notice, reply by way of affidavit of SHO, Police Station 31, Chandigarh, has been filed by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record.

As per reply, at the time of registration of the FIR, no name of any boy was given either by the complainant or his niece. The complainant's as well as his niece's statement was recorded and she stated that an unknown boy misbehaved with her and she saw the boy for the first time and was not from her locality. She further stated that if the boy is brought before her, she would be able to recognize him. The statement of the girl is annexed as Annexure A-1. As no further description was given either by the complainant or his niece with regard to the said incident therefore the investigating officer prepared the untraced report on 07.12.2015.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the matter and the present petition is disposed of as such.
