With the assistance of Ms. Savita Saxena, Advocate/Mediator, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. A written settlement/agreement dated 21.03.2017 duly signed by both the parties, has been placed on record. It has been agreed that Amarpreet Singh, husband of complainant, through his father and attorney-petitioner No.1, will file a petition for divorce under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act. He will also give Rs.12,00,000/- to Navneet Kaur-respondent No.2 as permanent alimony for past, present and future maintenance of minor child namely Sehajkirat Kaur (aged about 3 years). Both the parties will withdraw their respective proceedings filed against each other.

Since the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties,
this petition is disposed of in terms of the compromise/settlement deed
dated 21.03.2017.
