ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.226 dated 26.12.2015, under Sections 279, 337, 338 of IPC, registered at Police Station Mataur, District Mohali, on the basis of compromise dated 11.05.2017 (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden fight between the parties, which has been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 26.05.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to

genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, SAS Nagar (Mohali) dated 05.06.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a sudden fight between the parties, which has been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.226 dated 26.12.2015, under Sections 279, 337, 338 of IPC, registered at Police Station Mataur, District Mohali and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
