Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of necessary directions to the respondents in the context of protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner from being invaded at the hands of the accused Varinder Singh.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has also moved a representation before respondent No.3 on 08.05.2017 and the said representation is pending consideration before him.

It appears that the petitioner has approached respondent No.3 without approaching respondent No.5 at the first instance for registration of FIR in the context of allegations made in the representation dated 08.05.2017.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl. A.G.,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the pleadings contained in the present petition, respondent No.2 is directed to take into consideration the pending representation moved by the petitioner on 08.05.2017. In case some cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then Incharge, Police Station/SHO-respondent No.5 can be obligated to act in accordance with law. If no cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then the petitioner be informed as per parameters laid down in **Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC (1).**

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
