Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.59 dated 05.11.2011 under Sections 406 and 498-A I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar City, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 30.05.2017, parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/ trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar on 17.07.2017 and got recorded their

statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide her covering letter No.267 dated 20.07.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide letter No.1702G/JRK dated 21.07.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, the compromise between the parties is voluntary, without any pressure, coercion or undue influence from any quarter.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.59, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
