Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the offences against the petitioner are bailable and he has already been in custody for a period of more than two months, though he was earlier declared a proclaimed offender.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner was absconding since the year 2012 and was declared a proclaimed offender in the year 2014.

As regards the merits of the case, it is seen that the petitioner has been attributed a '*kirpan*' blow on the mother of the complainant.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition.
