This is an application for correcting name of father of the petitioner as Dharam Singh in place of Dharshan Singh.

At the asking of the Court Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab accepted notice.

The application is allowed.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has since joined the investigation. This fact is conceded by learned State counsel further stating that the recovery has been effected from him and in that way he is not required for further investigation by the police. She has stated so on

instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh from Police Station, Jhunir.

As a matter of fact, as per allegations, petitioner having a baseball bat had caused damage to windowpane of the car and no injury has been attributed to him.

Under such circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioner on 26.5.2017 is made absolute, subject to his fulfilling conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
