This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to provide adequate police protection/security to the petitioner and further prayed that respondent No.3 be directed not to harass and threaten the petitioner and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation dated 25.05.2015 (Annexure P-2).

Ludhiana is directed to decide the representation dated 25.05.2015 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
