Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.46 dated 28.04.2016 under Sections 452, 323, 341, 325/34 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Passiana, District Patiala, on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, the petitioners, as also respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the Area Magistrate on 05.07.2017 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the petitioners and respondent No.2 appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala and got recorded their statements for compromise. Report vide covering letter No.1506 dated

12.07.2017 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Patiala vide letter No.3652/AL dated 13.07.2017 has also been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala, the compromise between the parties is without any pressure and coercion and is voluntarily and genuine one.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.46, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
