This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to produce final report in FIR No.30 dated 01.02.2017 registered under Sections 323 and 376 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar against the accused persons i.e. respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar (Rural) to consider and decide the representation dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. N.K.Banka, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the case, respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar (Rural) is directed to decide the representation dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-3), by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
