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**INDERJIT SINGH, J.**

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.292 dated 29.04.2017 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per allegations, the petitioner got her name changed fraudulently in the municipal record. The petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial

interrogation. The case is based on documentary evidence. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find it a fit case, where the petitioner is entitled to benefit of grant of anticipatory bail. Therefore, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 30.05.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
