INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Saurabh Sharma has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.77 dated 06.08.2016, registered at Police Station Panjokhra, Ambala, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 302 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with knife and active role has

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been attributed to him. As per the general allegations, injuries have also been attributed to him.

Learned State counsel has brought into the notice of this Court that only one formal witness has been examined till now.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that one person has died; that two-three persons have also received injuries and that if the petitioner is released on bail, there are chances of tampering with the evidence by him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
